


NYC's 10 Outdoor Spots to Hydrate At Now


While I'm not technically an expert I will say that I have done my fair share of research and plan to keep researching all summer long. If you have a recommendation do share ASAP in the comments below!




The Go To: Grand Banks

My recommendation? Go during the weekend with a group of friends.



Let's just say ... This place. At sunset. With whomever you want. That is all. Oh and maybe with one of their insanely delicious cocktails in hand too.


