Genres will collide this Saturday when boxer Floyd Mayweather comes out of retirement to take on the UFC's biggest star, Conor McGregor.

Watching the Aug. 26 fight at home would run you a cool \$99.95 — and it won't match the atmosphere of a bar full of rowdy fans ready to see some action.
